NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- No entry will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees will be made.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered into the show. All entries must be made on Official AKC Entry Forms or copies and **must include the Agreement and Rules**. No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.
- Handlers may opt to run in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper height division.
- **Bitches in season and injured dogs** are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. **Please note:** Refund of entry fees for injured dogs or bitches entered in the trial that come in season after the closing date of this show may be obtained by sending a veterinarian's certificate to the trial secretary before the start of the show. Entry fees will be refunded less \$5.00 per run.
- Choke collars pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited on the trial grounds. Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. **Judges are not required to wait for dogs.** The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their own dogs. **Please** help us keep this site clean and available for future use.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$20 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a cash only basis.
- AVMA Statement: Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- These trials will be held indoors on turf. Crate mats are needed under crates. There is plenty of crating space. Crates may also be left in the building overnight.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form.

AKC rule on delivery of entries: Maximum of 10 dogs allowed in each envelope. No hand deliveries can be accepted in the first 24 hours after opening.

Please note that express mail deliveries should contain a signature allowing them to be left at the trial secretary's address without recipient's signature. Please provide an e-mail or a self-addressed stamped envelope if you would like to be notified before closing that your entries have been received. Method will be random draw.

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded for first through fourth place in each jump height in every class but T2B. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving qualifying scores. MACH, PACH, PAX & AGCH ribbons and new title ribbons are also available to qualifiers.

Ring size 70' x 115'

Obstacles will conform to current requirements of the AKC Agility Regulations. A regulation agility jump will be available for warm up in a designated area.

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of each class.

Move ups for Friday must be received in writing no later than 6:00pm Monday April 22, 2019. Move ups will be allowed for Saturday/ Sunday until the end of trial Friday/Saturday as a result of receiving a title.

Judging hours begin at 8:00am on Saturday and Sunday

Directions to Flying Feet

From New Albany - Take State Street (name will change into Paoli Pike) towards Floyds Knobs. Turn right on Scottsville Rd. Go approximately 3 miles. Turn right on Starlight Rd. Go about 1 mile and watch on right for a lake and stone mail box (7844) by asphalt drive. Do **not** take this entrance. Continue on a short distance and use the next gravel drive on the right. This will take you back to the training building.

From Interstate 64 - Take exit 119 - Hwy 150/Greenville/Paoli exit. Go 3.8 miles on Hwy 150. Turn right on Stiller Rd. Go 1.3 miles and turn right on Fertig Creek Rd. Go 1.5 miles. Cross straight over Scottsville Rd at the stop sign and you will be on Starlight Rd. Go about 1 mile and watch on right for a lake and stone mail box (7844) by asphalt drive. Do **not** take this entrance. Continue on a short distance and use the next gravel drive on the right. This will take you back to the training building.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners ProgramSM may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.
