*All FAST courses will be nested. Masters/Excellent will walk then run. Open and Novice will walk together and then run consecutively.

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course without a dog prior to the start of each class.

Trial Site

Obstacles will conform to current AKC Agility Regulations. Electronic Timers will be used at these trials.

Warm up/practice jump: Regulation agility jump will be set up in designated area.

•X-pens and crates may be left overnight.

•Neither Silver Street Park nor DCAA will be responsible for personal articles left at the site

•No dogs may be left overnight.

•Tarps or other waterproof mats **MUST** be used under all crates to protect turf from spills and pet hair. Tarps will be available for purchase from DCAA if you don't have one.

•No grooming is allowed inside the building.

•Please help us keep the facility tidy by picking up any excess pet hair and any trash around your crating space.

•Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused from the trial without refund.

•A \$10 fee will be charged for any dog soiling the turf.

•This facility requires any chair with 4 individual feet to be placed on a thick mat/rug/pad to protect the turf. Only chairs with a solid bar for feet, such as anti-gravity chairs, may sit directly on the turf.

From I-265/IN-62: Take Exit 4 for Charlestown Rd. Turn south toward New Albany. Continue for 2.4 miles. Turn right onto Silver St. Turn left into Silver Street Park.

Eligible Dogs

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Exceptions are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, and dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partner may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form.

Jump Height Card Process

There is a new section in the middle of the entry form to designate whether your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary

knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

Entry Fees

Fee for first and second class entry per day: \$19 per run. Fee for additional classes per day: \$16 per run. Checks should be made out to **DCAA**. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$20 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a cash only basis. **If using club vouchers, please limit vouchers to no more than 50% of entry fees.**

Please note, express mail deliveries should contain a signature allowing them to be left at the trial secretary's address without recipient's signature. Maximum of 10 dogs are allowed in each envelope. Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered into the show. All entries must be made on Official AKC Entry Forms or copies and must include the Agreement and Rules. No entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

Confirmations

For those who provide an e-mail address entry received confirmations will be sent as entries are received. Entry accepted confirmations will be sent after the draw. Please be sure to have your e-mail address printed clearly on entry form. After closing date final confirmation and judging schedule will be sent via e-mail. Confirmation via the postal service will only occur if you enclose a self-addressed, stamped postcard with your entry. Judging schedule, worker schedule and exhibitor information will also be available on the trial secretary website, www.loulees-shelties.com after closing.

Refunds

No refunds for overpayment of \$10.00 or less. No entry will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. A refund of 100% of the entry fees will be given for any reason if the request is received prior to closing by the Trial Secretary in writing or e-mail. After closing and prior to the trial starting, entry fees (less \$5/per run. for AKC and administrative fees) will be refunded for injured dogs, injured handlers, and bitches in season. The Trial Committee may require a doctor/vet's letter for injuries. Refund requests received after the start of the Trial will not be given for any reason.

Wait List

DCAA is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing Friday October 4, 2019 at 6:00 pm. A maximum of 20 entries will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to Friday October 4, 2019 at 6:00 pm. Any entries withdrawn that are received by October 4, 2019 will be replaced by a wait listed entry

if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by Monday, October 14, 2019 will receive a full refund. A dog withdrawn from the wait list before October 4, 2019 will receive a full refund.

Notice to Exhibitors

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and children. Any exhibitor whose dogs or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked to leave the show site by the Trial Committee. In such case, no refund of any fees will be made. Minor children must be supervised at all times. Failure to do so may result in being asked to leave the show site by the Trial Committee.
- Pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars, head halter, and special training collars are prohibited on the trial grounds. This includes bark collars.
- Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or designated agility warm-up area. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their own dogs. Please help us keep this site clean future use. Hotels/motels are considered to be part of the show environs.
- **AVMA Statement:** Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs have appropriate vaccinations and are free of internal and external parasites and communicable diseases.

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial **or back-to-back trials** only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine Partners** SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner? _____
