HEIGHT CARDS. It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. Additionally, if a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running.

Directions

From the South, take SR41 North thru Terre Haute. Turn right (East) onto Haythorne Ave, which is north of the traffic light at Ft Harrison and SR41. Watch for Wetnight RV's, the turn is just north of that business.

At the next 4 way stop, turn right onto 13th Street and the entrance to Strive 365 will be the second driveway on the right.

From the North, take SR63 to Terre Haute. At the SR63 and SR41 merge go north on SR41 and follow the above directions. Please note that the first traffic light you will encounter after the 63/41 merge will be the SR41 and Ft Harrison intersection.

From the East or West, find SR41 (I70 exit will work) or SR 63 (I74 exit) and follow the above direction

Prizes & Awards

Rosettes will be awarded for 1st through 4th place in each jump height in each class (dogs must qualify to receive a placement). Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. New title and QQ ribbons will be awarded. Special new title ribbon will be awarded to dogs completing the PAX.MX MXJ MXP or MJP titles. Dogs earning a MACH or PACH will be awarded a bar and title ribbon. All prizes to be claimed the day of the trial, none will be mailed.

Notice to Exhibitors

Special Note: dogs must be 15 months or older to enter this trial.

Safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from the competition by action of the Trial Committee.

Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in excusal from the ring.

All dogs MUST be on-leash, crated, securely penned, or otherwise under physical control at all times when not competing or at the practice jump.

It is expressly understood exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund of any fee paid will be made.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by means of riot, civil disturbance, fire, act of God, emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Dogs are not required to be at the Trial until scheduled time of judging; however, exhibitors are responsible for being at the ringside when it is their turn to run. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up the class. Please check in with the Gate Steward.

Refunds: A refund of 100% of the entry fees will be given for any reason, if the request is received by the Trial Secretary in writing or emailed, prior to closing. After closing and prior to trial starting, entry fees (less administrative, judging and AKC fees) will be refunded for: injured dogs, injured handlers, and bitches in season (when a letter from your veterinarian is presented before 8:00 am the first day of the trial). A doctor/vet's letter may be required for injuries, at the discretion of the Trial Committee. Refund of entry fees will be refunded less \$5.00 per run. Requests for refunds received after the start of the trial will not be given for any reason. In accordance with *AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows*, no dogs under the age of 4 months are allowed on the show site. All AKC rules apply regarding toys and food in the ring.

- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$20 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. **No refunds given for overpayment of less than \$10.00.**

** Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations for the state in which they are competing.

Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. For example, the same dog may now be entered in Regular FAST and/or T2B to finish up those titles while also entered in Preferred Master STD/JWW to start working towards their PACH at the lower height. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed.

Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

As of January 1, 2020, For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring
 - Toys must be non-audible
 - Toys may not leave the handler's hand
 - Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

Fix and Go On (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.
