Eligible Dogs

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Exceptions are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, and dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partner may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form.

Jump Height Card Process

There is a new section in the middle of the entry form to designate whether your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

Entry Fees

Fee for each class entry per day: \$18 per run. Checks should be made out to **CISSC**. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$20 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a cash only basis.

Please note, express mail deliveries should contain a signature allowing them to be left at the trial secretary's address without recipient's signature. Maximum of 10 dogs are allowed in each envelope. Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered into the show. All entries must be made on Official AKC Entry Forms or copies and must include the Agreement and Rules. No entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

Confirmations

For those who provide an e-mail address entry received confirmations will be sent as entries are received. Entry accepted confirmations will be sent after the draw. Please be sure to have your e-mail address printed clearly on entry form. After closing date final confirmation and judging schedule will be sent via e-mail. Confirmation via the postal service will only occur if you enclose a self-addressed, stamped postcard with your entry. Judging schedule, worker schedule and exhibitor information will also be available on the trial secretary website, www.loulees-shelties.com after closing.

Refunds

No entry will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entries may be withdrawn at anytime. Fees will be fully refunded (checks shredded) before closing. After closing fees will be refunded minus AKC fees and the closing date is just a week before the trial dates.

Wait List

CISSC is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing Friday July 24, 2020 at 6:00 pm. A maximum of 20 entries will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to Friday July 24, 2020 at 6:00 pm. Any entries withdrawn that are received by July 24, 2020 will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by Monday, July, 24 2020 will receive a full refund. A dog withdrawn from the wait list before July 24, 2020 will receive a full refund.

Notice to Exhibitors

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and children. Any exhibitor whose dogs or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked to leave the show site by the Trial Committee. In such case, no refund of any fees will be made. Minor children must be supervised at all times. Failure to do so may result in being asked to leave the show site by the Trial Committee.
- Pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars, head halter, and special training collars are prohibited on the trial grounds. This includes bark collars.
- Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or designated agility warm-up area. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their own dogs. Please help us keep this site clean future use. Hotels/motels are considered to be part of the show environs.
- **AVMA Statement:** Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs have appropriate vaccinations and are free of internal and external parasites and communicable diseases.

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lesser of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner? _____

Thank you for working with us to keep dogs and people safe while we conduct an agility trial in these unusual circumstances. We want you to be aware of what we are planning and make sure your entry is made with an understanding of our plans and expectations of exhibitors.

We plan on adhering to CDC, local government, facility and AKC guidelines. As those guidelines are updated, we may have to modify these expectations. We will notify you prior to the date of the trial if the agility committee determines more or less stringent measures are needed. We will shred your check if you decide not to participate prior to the closing date. Withdrawals after the closing date will be minus the AKC fee. **Do not compete if you feel ill or have been exposed to someone who has symptoms of COVID-19. If you feel ill on the day of trial, please stay home.**

If you choose to enter you should be aware of the following:

Building Restrictions

- There will be **no** spectators in the building. If you choose to crate your dog inside, you cannot remain with your dog. Also, we cannot allow anyone inside to video your run or to watch your run.
- Building occupancy will be limited. This potentially limits your “at will” access to restrooms or to crated dogs.
- Entered dogs may be crated in the building or outdoors. No unentered dogs crated in the building
- We will designate separate entrance and exit doors so please watch for signage.
- No eating or drinking inside. Note - no food can be stored in the refrigerator or inside the building.

Masks

- We will be mandating mask wearing in the building except when running. Wearing your mask means covering your mouth and nose. We will have a limited number of masks available for purchase.
- Masks will be required during the walk through.
- Ring crew will be wearing a mask.

Safety and Sanitation

- We will have a few children’s wading pools for the dogs.
- Be aware that the outdoor ring will be in use. Enter the parking lot slowly!
- Please close/cover dog crates and remove all dog food/water before you leave on Saturday as we will be using cleaning products.
- We will have hand sanitizer available and hand soap in bathrooms.
- We will be wiping down interior surfaces often.

Changes to normal trial practices

- Course maps will be emailed to you and posted on the wall. No copies will be made.

- During runs leashes may be placed in pocket if leash can fully fit in pocket. We will also have a leash runner/bar setter who will use a pickup stick.
- As necessary to comply with occupancy limits, walk throughs will be divided.
- Social distancing will be observed when lining up to enter the ring and throughout the trial. Social distancing will be in place for check in, ribbon distribution posting of results and other trial practices.

Outside of the building

- We encourage you to bring easy ups so you can be more comfortable outside.
- No facility chairs will be available to exhibitors. Bring your own chairs for outside use.
- We encourage you to wear a mask and maintain social distancing while outside.

Inclement Weather

- If inclement weather forces us to use the indoor ring for the jumpers classes we will still limit occupancy and exhibitors should plan on staying in their cars until it is time for their run.
- In the event of a tornado warning, the building will be opened to exhibitors.

We understand that this is a lot to digest and this is new to all of us. We thank you in advance for your patience, understanding and cooperation.

Assumption of Risk and Waiver of Liability Related to Covid – 19

Central Indiana Shetland Sheep Dog Club (“the Club”) and Pawsative Partners Dog Training Center (PPDTC) have put in place preventative measures to reduce the spread of COVID-19; however, neither the Club or PPDTC can guarantee that you will not become infected with COVID-19. Further, attending the Club sponsored agility trial at PPDTC could increase your risk of contracting COVID-19.

By signing this agreement, I acknowledge the contagious nature of COVID-19 and voluntarily assume the risk that I may be exposed to or infected by COVID-19 by attending the Club’s agility trial at PPDTC and that such exposure or infection may result in personal injury, illness, permanent disability, and death.
