Please note, express mail deliveries should contain a signature allowing them to be left at the trial secretary's address without recipient's signature. Please provide an e-mail if you would like to be notified before closing that your entries have been received. AKC rule on delivery of entries: Maximum of 10 dogs are allowed in each envelope. Method will be First Received. No hand deliveries the first 24 hours of opening.

Entry Fees: \$18 for first & second class per dog per day, \$15 for each additional class per dog per day. (\$18 / \$18 / \$15 / \$15 / \$15)

Online Entries: No online entries will be taken for this event.

OBSTACLES: Obstacles will conform to the requirements in the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

Electronic timing will be used.

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form.

- * Safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- * It is expressly understood exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund of any fee paid will be made. Any incidents of dog aggression resulting in harm to other dogs or people that occur within the show grounds will be reported by the Show Committee to the proper authorities.
- * Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from the competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- * All dogs MUST be on-leash, crated, securely penned, or otherwise under physical control at all times when not competing or at the practice jump.
- * No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by means of riot, civil disturbance, fire, or an act of God, emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- * Dogs are not required to be at the Trial until scheduled time of judging; however, exhibitors are responsible for being at the ringside when it is their turn to run. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up the class. Please check in with the Gate Steward.
- * Entries are opened upon receipt and exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and LEGIBLE information on entry forms as well as correct fees; illegible or incomplete entries WILL be returned. Fill in all the blanks, please.
- * EVENT COMMITTEE WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.
- * All exhibitors must pick up dog waste everywhere on the show grounds. The site will be monitored and offenders will be asked to leave. In such cases, no refunds will be made. Hotels/motels are considered to be part of the show environs.
- * BITCHES IN SEASON are not allowed to compete. After closing, upon presentation of a written veterinary certificate there will be refund minus \$10.00 per day processing fee for bitches in season and injured dogs. No AKC fee for bitches in season. An injury is any wound or damage to the body resulting from physical activity. Some common injury types are: cut, abrasion, fracture and burn. Sprain and strain injuries to muscles, joints and connective tissues are classified as injuries. All documentation must be received by the trial secretary 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

No moving down or changing of height after closing except as specified in Chapter 1 Section 21 of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

Jump Height Cards

Jump height cards are not required to be submitted with the entry form. The entry form has a spot to indicate if the dog needs to be measured. If the dog needs to be measured, it is the handler's responsibility to ensure that the box on the entry form is checked, and that the dog is measured prior to running. The jump height box on the entry form **MUST** be filled in.

Important Trial Site Notes

- Tarps or other waterproof mats **MUST** be used under all crates to protect turf spills and pet hair. Tarps will be available for purchase from ACSI if you don't have one.
- No grooming is allowed inside the building. Please help us keep the facility tidy by picking up any excess pet hair and all trash around your crating space.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused from the trial without refund. A \$10 fee will be charged for any dog soiling the turf
- This facility requires any chair with 4 individual feet to be placed on a thick mat/rug/pad to protect the turf. Only chairs with a solid bar for feet, such as anti-gravity chairs, may sit directly on the turf.
- There will be no early setup for competitors on Thursday. The building will be open Friday/Saturday/Sunday morning for crating setup. Please check the welcome letter sent after closing for exact times.

Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. For example, the same dog may now be entered in Regular FAST and/or T2B to finish up those titles while also entered in Preferred Master STD/JWW to start working towards their PACH at the lower height. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed.

Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

As of January 1, 2020, For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST.

Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.

- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring
 - Toys must be non-audible
 - Toys may not leave the handler's hand
 - Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

Fix and Go On (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

There is no RV parking allowed on-site. Parking is adequate for cars/trucks/SUVs, but we unfortunately do not have room to accommodate RVs/ travel trailers. There are a few campgrounds in the area and a Walmart about a mile from the site on Grant Line Road.



Everyone's safety is our primary concern, especially during the current pandemic. We will comply with Indiana state guidelines for reopening the state and group events. **Please keep in mind this is a very fluid situation, and state and local guidelines are subject to change with little notice. We reserve the right to adjust these guidelines as needed.** We will try to keep everyone updated of any changes through our Facebook page and emails from the trial secretary. We will be implementing the following guidelines:

1. Crating should be setup so that social distancing can be maintained between handlers at a minimum of 6 feet.
2. Walk through groups will be split to facilitate better social distancing.
3. Anyone entering the building will need to wear a mask, which will include all workers and ring crew. Exhibitors are responsible for providing their own mask. Exhibitors may remove their mask when entering the ring for their run and place it in their pocket, but you must put the mask on prior to exiting the ring.
4. Exhibitors should maintain six-foot social distancing inside and outside the building. Please be respectful of your fellow exhibitors.
5. There will be no seating/viewing area near the ring. Seating will only be in your crating area and bleachers, maintaining 6 feet between you and the other handlers.
6. Tape will be placed on the floor for the person waiting to go in the ring as well as the next competitor. These will be 6 feet apart.

7. Handlers may place their leash in their pocket or wear them while running the course. If handlers elect to drop their leash as the start, a leash runner will use a sanitized grabber to pick up and transport the leash.

8. Results will be posted on the wall of the facility. Tape will be on the ground so that if you wish to view results, you can maintain social distancing. Results will be emailed after the trial as well.

9. Course maps will be posted on the wall. There will not be any paper course maps so plan on taking a picture of the maps.

10. There will not be food or beverages at the trial. Competitors will need to bring their own food and drinks.

11. Please do not bring MACH cakes or desserts to share with exhibitors.

12. Ribbons will not be self-serve. A worker will place stickers on them and place them on a table for pickup.

13. There will be plenty of soap and paper towels. Please wash your hands frequently. We will have hand sanitizer and disinfecting supplies, but we appreciate competitors bringing their own for personal use also.

If you are entering this trial, be sure you are comfortable with the above guidelines and are willing to comply with social distancing and wearing a mask. Exhibitors not complying with these guidelines will be excused from the trial without refund.

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners ProgramSM may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box..

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.
